## **AUTISM DOCUMENTATION**

**Autistic Disorder (F84.0)** 

#### **Problem List**

#### Add Autism to the Problem List.

• Keep the problem list upated



#### **Billing Diagnosis**

# Document at least once per calendar year for accurate Risk Adjustment

Also, capture for visits when Autism impacts:

- Management of acute conditions
- Scheduling (e.g., extra time for behavior/sensory needs)
- Deviation from standard treatment protocols

#### **Comorbid Diagnoses**

#### Does the patient have any additional diagnoses?

- Speech Delays (Expressive/Receptive)
- Motor Delays (Fine/Gross)
- Intellectual Delay (Mild, Moderate, Severe, Profound)
- ADHD (Inattentive, Hyperactive, Combined)

These impact risk scoring and treatment planning.

#### **Plan of Care**

# Use MEAT (Monitor, Evaluate, Assess, Treat) in your note to justify diagnosis and treatment

#### Include:

- Review of specialist notes or visit updates
- Current Autism-related symptoms or behavior issues
- Academic Support needs (e.g., IEP, 504 Plan)
- Referrals (Speech, OT, PT, ABA, Nutrition, Psych, etc.)
- Related prescriptions (e.g., medications, diapers, DME, communication aids)
- Education provided (e.g., safety, nutrition for picky eating)
